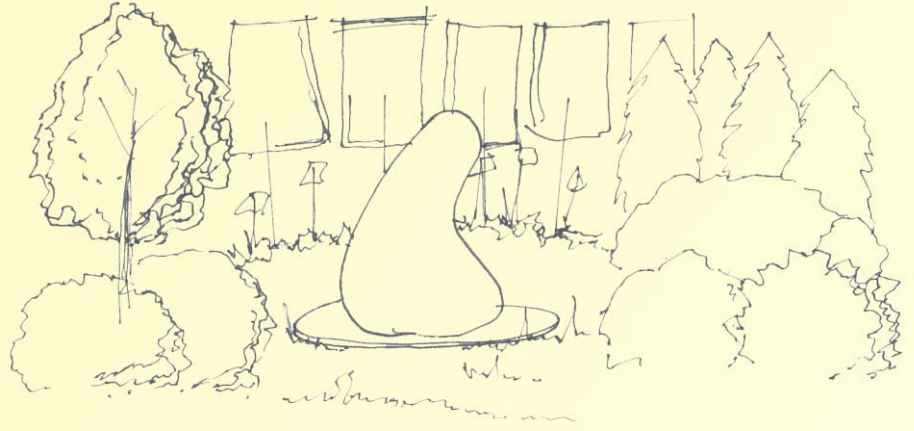


# HOW TO BUILD AN... ART PLATFORM

## TOOLS:

- (8) Shovels
- (4) Picks
- (6) Rakes
- (4) Wheelbarrows
- Water Access & hose
- (1) Concrete Trowel
- Roundup and sprayers
- Inverted Marking Paint

## ILLUSTRATIVE DRAWING



## MATERIALS:

- (60) 60 lb. Bag of Quickcrete @ \$2.87 = \$172.20
- (4) 8' Metal Edging @ \$9.68 = \$38.72
- (67) 2 cu. ft. bags of Hardwood Mulch @ \$2.35 = \$157.45
- (64) Nature's Helper Top Soil @ \$2.70 = \$172.80

## TOTAL COSTS:

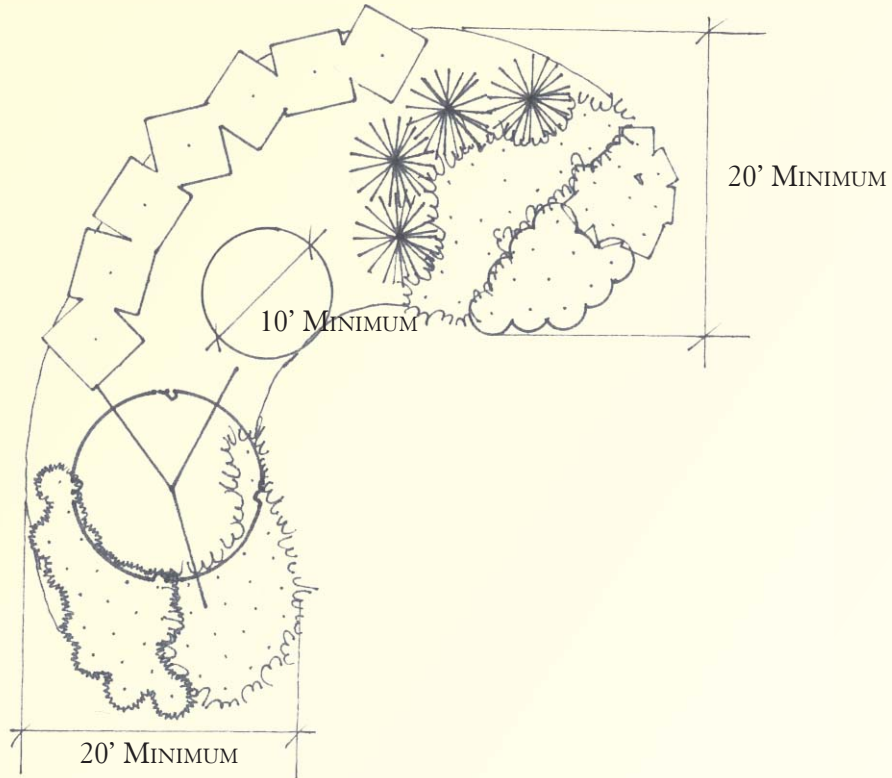
- tool rental @ \$100.00
- materials @ \$545.65
- total costs @ \$645.65



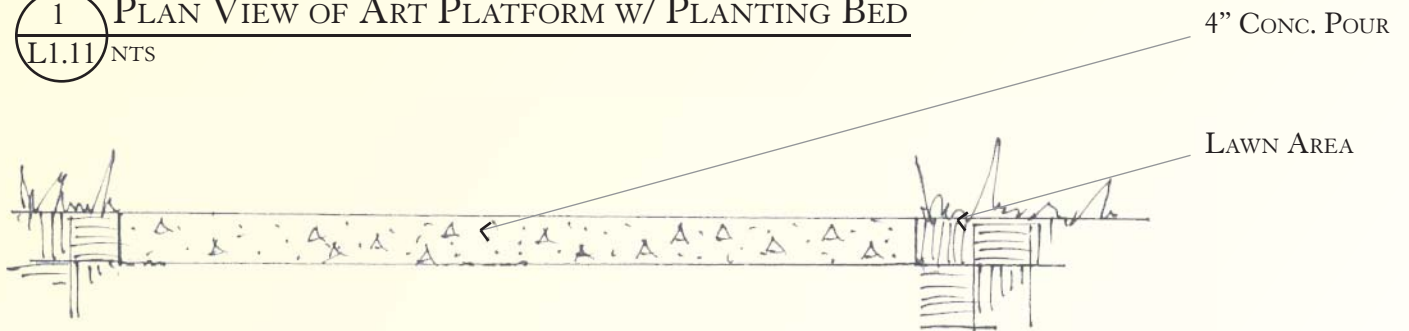
## GENERAL INFORMATION:

- 2 weeks prior to work day outline planting bed
- Outline and spray a 20% Round-Up spray on entire area. Sprayers can be borrowed from Ayanna @ Park Pride. (404) 723-3116
- Lay out platform with metal edging 1" above existing grade.
- Mix concrete in wheelbarrow according to package directions.
- Pour concrete into metal edge form and vibrate. To vibrate simply beat on form with hammer or shovel end to encourage air to exit concrete mix.
- Allow concrete to cure for time indicated on package.
- Provide bed edging with shovels.
- Turn all soil inside bedline with shovels.
- Plant bed according to planting plan and plants available.
- Return to water up to 1-1/2" per week
