- (10) shovels
- (10) tamps
- (10) garden rakes
- (4) wheelbarrows

Plant Materials

- (9) oakleaf hydrangea
- (3) summersweet clethera
- (15) bearded iris
- (10) umbrella palm
- (6) horsetail
- (3) bullrush
- (6) fountain grass
- (5) inkberry holly

Hardscape Materials

- (2) tons of river boulders
\$160/ton (\$320)
- 400sq.ft. of hardwood mulch
at 3" deep \$24/cu.yd (\$96.00)
- 800sq.ft. of leaf litter \$32/
cu.yd.
- 400 sq.ft of sand \$5.48/bag
(\$219.20)
- 400sq.ft. of top soil \$2.77/
bag (\$55.40)

TOTAL COSTS:

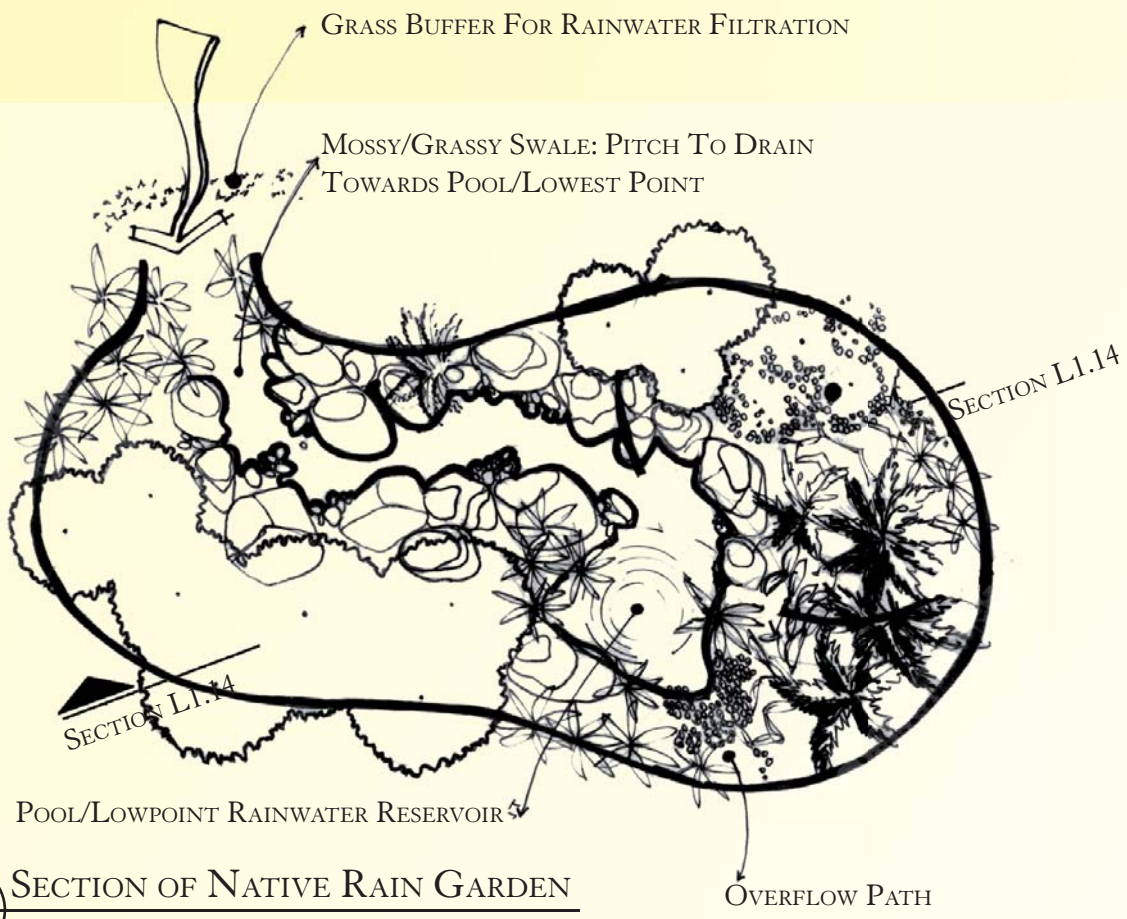
- tool rental @ \$100.00

GENERAL INFORMATION:

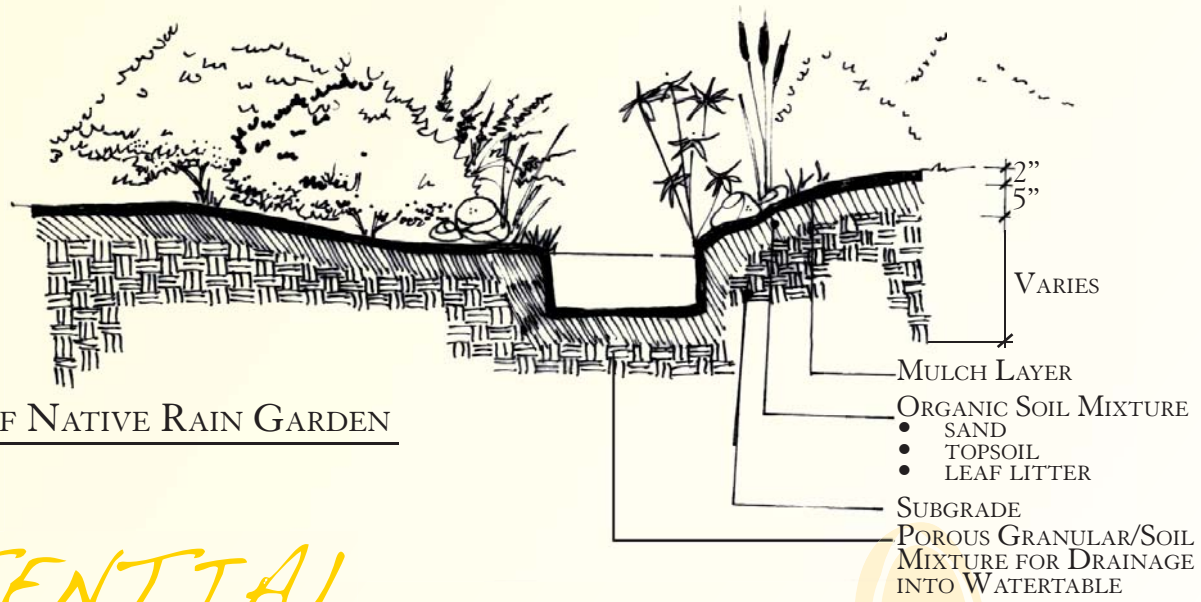
- This project is for those who wish to take on a more challenging project.
