DIRECTIONS:

Take I-20 West to exit 51A

Bare to the right off of exit 51 A towards Adamsville-Martin Luther King

Turn Right on Martin Luther King- You will see the Wayfield Foods

Turn right onto Fairburn Road

After you turn right, go to first traffic light turn left onto Collier Drive --You will see Jackson Memorial Baptist Church there on the corner...

Park Pride, founded in 1989, is a nonprofit organization that leads and inspires action for the creation of new parks and greenspace, and the improvement of existing ones. In 2005, Park Pride developed master plans for three new parks, organized a dozen of friends of park groups, successfully advocated for \$105 million in park improvement bonds and a \$2.6 million increase in the annual parks budget. In addition, Park Pride volunteers spent more than 23,000 hours cleaning and maintaining parks. Park Pride also successfully advocated for and legislation was passed to fund the Atlanta Beltline, a project that will create 1000 acres of new parks and 33 miles of trails in the city of Atlanta.
