PROFESSIONAL, FREE DESIGN HELP FOR YOUR PARK

Atlanta, Georgia – Park Pride will host its 4th Annual Community Park Design Clinic on Saturday, September 13 at 1:00 p.m at the Atlanta Botanical Garden. This year’s clinic will focus on gateways, entrances, and transitions. People’s perceptions of parks can be greatly influenced by the view into the park from the street. What is your park’s “curb appeal?” and how can it be enhanced to create a more positive image of the park? Is there a specific point of entry? Do vehicles and pedestrians enter the park differently? Are entry points well located and marked? Are they enticing? Landscape professionals will provide individual assistance as they help you develop designs that address these and other issues.

The four-hour clinic will take place at the Atlanta Botanical Garden’s Orchid House Classroom. Admission is free. To register, complete and submit the site evaluation form available at www.parkpride.org. The registration deadline is close of business on **Friday, September 5th**. There will be no exceptions, and seats are limited.
